Addendum 3 to PPC-IE Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) System RFP December 12, 2016

- 1. In setting a proposal due date for the AMI project, we mistakenly referred the 2016 calendar. The due date has been changed to 4:00 PM Tuesday January 10, 2017.
- 2. There was a question about the location of gas meters. The addresses provided are service addresses and are valid for all services at the location. At most locations there are both electric and a gas meters. There are a number of locations where there is only one service.
- 3. We received a question about indoor meters. Island Energy has a handful of indoor meters. It is probably easiest to assume all meters are outdoors. We will inquire about added costs for indoor meters during the follow up or handle the few that are out there as change orders.
- 4. We received an inquiry about prevailing wage requirements. The meter installation component of the project will require prevailing wage and that requirement will be in the contract if we choose to have the winning bidder provide meter change out services. Bidders should assume the meter change out work will be performed by the craft of Meter Technician. The table below provides rates that should be assumed for work performed in 2017. Health and Welfare, Holiday and Vacation are required hourly employer payments. Changes in craft determination and rates will be handled as a change order. Standard overtime policies would apply.
