- 1. To be eligible for rebate applicant must be a commercial customer with an active meter service with Island Energy and participate voluntarily in the Island Energy's Commercial Rebate Programs.
- 2. If applicant is installing product(s) and/or equipment at more than one facility, a separate application must be submitted for each location with a service ID number.
- 3. An applicant having only a leasehold interest is responsible for obtaining the property owner's permission to install the measure. Applicant's signature on the application warrants that the owner's permission is obtained.
- 4. For Motors & Process Improvement and Compressed Air System Improvement projects, an Investment Level Audit Report is required to outline proposed efficiency measures and show potential energy savings. In order to qualify for a rebate, the Investment Level Audit Report must demonstrate at least 10% of energy savings over the applicant's current average annual electric consumption.
- 5. Along with this application, applicant must submit copies of the receipt(s) and/or invoice(s) for the purchase of any product(s) or equipment and a copy of an Investment Level Audit Report if applicable.
- 6. Any product(s) or equipment that have been purchased and installed must meet the energy eligibility requirements for each stated product (as defined in the Catalog). Island Energy has sole discretion in verification of product(s) and/or equipment eligibility and energy savings with contractor or energy solution company who installed the measures and sole discretion in determination of rebate amount.
- 7. Applicant agrees to purchase 100% energy use from Island Energy for a minimum two (2) years from the installation date. If applicant fails to do so or ceases to be a customer of Island Energy during the two (2) year period, applicant is required to refund a prorated amount of rebate dollars based on the date of installation and the date of service termination.
- 8. All products and/or equipment must be installed at the claimed facility within nine months after the application being filed with Island Energy. It is applicant's responsibility to inform Island Energy that the installation is complete and the subject products and/or equipment are fully functional and operational.
- 9. The applicant must allow a representative or authorized third party reasonable access to the facility to verify the product(s) or equipment that has been installed before a rebate is paid. The rebate will not be paid if applicant refuses to participate in any required verification. The verification of installation must be scheduled within 30 days of request by Island Energy. Island Energy has the right to contact the qualifying product vendor or installer, if needed, to verify purchase and/or installation.
- 10. It is applicant's responsibility to install the product(s) and equipment in accordance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, building codes and manufacturer's specifications.
- 11. After the inspection and verification are completed, Island Energy will issue a written notice of acceptance specifying estimated energy savings, rebate amounts and other conditions.
- 12. Island Energy will issue only one rebate for each qualifying product and/or piece of equipment. Applicant can not apply for rebate for the same product and/or equipment from third party energy-efficiency programs offering rebates, financing or other rebates funded with California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) mandated Public Benefits Fund.
- 13. The utility makes no representation or warrant, and assumes no liability with respect to quality, safety, performance, or other aspect of any design, system or appliance installed pursuant to this agreement.
